SUBJECT: Calling Notice for NATO CBRN EOD Incident Management Staff Officer Training, Slovakia, 19 – 23 October 2020.

DATE: 18 June 2020

1. Based on the NATO requirements on education and training in EOD area, the NATO EOD COE delivers **NATO CBRN EOD Incident Management Staff Officer Training (NATO CBRN EOD IM SOT)**.
2. NATO/IP nations are invited to attend the NATO CBRN EOD IM SOT, which will take place in Trencin, Slovakia from **19 to 23 October 2020**.
3. Deadline for registration is **4 September 2020**. The maximum number of seats in the course is limited to 16 students.
4. NATO CBRN EOD IM SOT provides EOD Staff Officers with training on CBRN EOD Incident Management up to brigade staff level during multinational operations aiming to advise commander on chemical, biological and radiological explosive ordnance disposal and CBR IED matters.
5. The NATO CBRN EOD IM SOT is recorded in NATO Education and Training Opportunities Catalogue (ETOC) as NATO approved course (ETOC course code MEG-EO-32127). ANNEX A

to Calling Notice for NATO CBRN EOD IM SOT, 19-23OCT2020

ADMINISTRATIVE GUIDANCE

1. GENERAL OVERVIEW

a) Scope:

The NATO EOD COE in cooperation with partner nations and institutions as NATO Joint CBRN Defence Centre of Excellence, ITA CIED COE, ECMAN, GBR DEMS Training Regiment and Armed Forces of the Slovak republic will deliver the NATO CBRN EOD IM SOT on 19 - 23 October 2020.

The NATO CBRN EOD IM SOT is based on current versions of important EOD and CBRN related NATO Standardization agreements (with primary focus on STANAG 2609 AEODP 8 "Interservice CBRN EOD on multinational deployments" and STANAG 2143 AEODP-10 "Minimum standards of proficiency for trained EOD personnel").

b) Aim:

The aim of the NATO CBRN EOD Staff Officer Incident Management Training is to train qualified personnel (EOD staff officers) in managing CBRN EOD incident up to brigade staff level during multinational operations and advising commander on chemical, biological and radiological explosive ordnance disposal and CBR IED matters.

c) Target Audience:

As a first priority, EOD Staff officers or Senior NCOs assigned or intended to be assigned as Officers at the Combined Joint EOD Cell, EOD Coordination Cell, EOD Cell or as a National EOD Point of Contact during multinational deployments.

The EOD Staff officers assigned to national positions related to CBRN EOD will be accepted IAW NATO EOD COE seats allocation policy.

Language skills: IAW STANAG 6001, an adequate understanding of written and spoken English is expected from the course attendees. SLP 2222 is recommended as the minimum level of English language proficiency.

d) Performance Objectives:

1. EOD Staff officer is able to apply CBRN EOD threat management including CBRN weapons
2. EOD Staff officer is able to advice commander on CBRN Explosive ordnance disposal.
3. EOD Staff officer is able to manage CBRN EOD Incident within the overall spectrum of EOD tasks.

NATO CBRN EOD IM SOT is to be advanced level course for EOD Officers. Training will be based on balanced level of theoretical lessons, field demonstration of CBRN and EOD capabilities, syndicate work and final exercise, where management of incidents will be exercised.

Training will not address principles in disposal of nuclear weapons and during final exercise, the chemical and biological scenarios are to be concerned only.

e) Security Classification:

The Security Clearance for this training is NATO Unclassified.

f) Training Area:

The course will be organized and delivered at the training premises of NATO EOD COE in Trenčín. However, demonstration of EOD and CBRN capabilities will be held in SVK National EOD and CBRN Centre in Novaky. NATO EOD COE will provide transportation of the attendees from Trenčín to Novaky and back.

2. EXECUTION

Attendees are expected to arrive to Trenčín no later than **on Monday 19 October 2020, 07:00 AM.**

The course will be finished no later than on Friday, 23 October 2020, 12:00 hrs.

a) Registration:

Nations applying for seats on this course should follow the instructions listed below:

1. Contact the NATO EOD COE Point of Contact (Admin) by e-mail, sending an **electronic version of the Registration Form** which is available at the following link: <https://eodcoe.org/en/education-training/education-individual-training-eampt-activities-2020/nato-cbrn-eod-im-sot/>
2. For the registration are to be used only official organization's e-mail addresses. In any other case, please contact your EOD related national POC.
3. The registration deadline is set on **4 September 2020. Registration Forms submitted after the deadline will not be accepted.**
4. All applicants will receive a confirmation letter or a regret letter from the Admin **NLT 16 September 2020.** It is highly recommended that no applicant start managing the arrangements before receiving the confirmation of admission to the course!

b) In-processing:

In processing will be carried out from **07:30 to 08:00AM** at the NATO EOD COE – Olbrachtova 5, Trenčín, Slovakia on the first day of the course.

Each attendee should be in possession of:

- ID card (e.g. passport) as listed in the registration form,
- NATO Travel Order or equivalent.

c) Course fee:

A course administration fee of **346 €** per attendee will be collected on the first day of the course. Course fee does not apply for students from the NATO EOD COE Sponsoring Nations (CZE, HUN, POL, ROU and SVK).

d) Dress code:

BDU for military personnel (no helmet, no weapon).

Each student is advised to bring his/her waterproof jacket and adverse weather gear in case the weather deteriorates (rain, wind).

3. SERVICE SUPPORT

a) Transportation:

Arrival by air / bus / car:

The recommended airport is Vienna (Austria). To reach the city of Trencin attendees can use a rental car or public transportation means (bus).
