1. Based on the NATO/IP customer's demand for education and training in the EOD area, the NATO EOD COE delivers the **Homemade Explosives Course – Basic (HMEC-B)**.
2. NATO/IP nations are invited to attend the HMEC-B, which will take place at **the Combat Support Training Center in Ramnicu Valcea, Romania, on 23 - 25 September 2025**.
3. The deadline for registration is **25 July 2025**. The maximum number of seats available in the course is limited to 16 students.

ANNEX A

to Calling Notice for HMEC-B, 23-25 SEPTEMBER 2025

ADMINISTRATIVE GUIDANCE

1. GENERAL OVERVIEW

a) Scope:

NATO EOD COE will deliver the HMEC-B in cooperation with the Combat Support Training Center, Ramnicu Valcea, Romania. Two days will be dedicated to basics – classroom-led lessons about explosives, their characteristics and HME chemistry plus demonstrations. One day will be focused on the HME clandestine laboratory demonstration with students' participation.

b) Aim:

This course is designed to assist nations in educating EOD non-qualified personnel, or EOD personnel with limited HME knowledge, in relevant information about homemade explosives at an awareness level of proficiency. Students will be able to detect and identify HME precursors by human senses, set up relevant safety measures and report the incident when an HME hazard is present.

c) Target Audience:

Applicants should be EOD non-qualified personnel or EOD personnel with no/rudimentary HME knowledge.

Language skills: IAW STANAG 6001, an adequate understanding of written and spoken English is expected from the course attendees. SLP 2222 is recommended as the minimum level of proficiency.

d) Performance Objectives:

1. Explain the properties of HME and their precursors.
2. Describe the characteristics of HME labs.
3. Examine HME challenges.

e) Security Classification:

The Security Clearance for this course is NATO UNCLASSIFIED.

f) Training Area:

The course will be organized and delivered in the **Combat Support Training Center in Ramnicu Valcea, Romania**. Be aware that the course does not take place in the city of Trenčín, Slovakia, where the EOD COE is located.

2. EXECUTION

Attendees are expected to arrive in front of the Hotel Simfonia in Ramnicu Valcea NLT **on Tuesday, 23 September 2025, 07:45 AM**, where the Combat Support Training Centre's bus will pick them up. The course will be finished no later than 17:00 PM on Thursday, 18 September 2025. **No returning flight should be booked before Thursday, 25 September, 22:00 PM.** Monday and Friday are designated as travel days for attendees.

a) Registration:

Nations applying for seats on this course should follow the instructions listed below:

1. Registration can only be done electronically through the EOD COE web page at the following link: <https://eodcoe.org/en/education-training/education-individual-training-eit-activities-2025/hmec-basic/>
2. In case of any issues, contact the EOD COE Point of Contact by e-mail.
3. The registration deadline is set for **25 July 2025**. Registration Forms submitted after the deadline will not be accepted.
4. Do not begin the registration process without resolving your course financing.
5. All applicants will receive a Confirmation Letter or a Regret Letter from the Action Officer **NLT on 4 August 2025**. It is highly recommended that no applicant starts managing the arrangements before receipt the confirmation of admission to the course!

b) In-processing:

In-processing will be carried out from **08:00 to 08:30 AM** on the 1st day of the course.

Each attendee should be in possession of:

- ID card (e.g. passport) as listed in the registration form,
- NATO Travel Order or equivalent.

c) Course fee:

A course administration fee is 200 € per attendee. The method of payment will be indicated in the Confirmation Letter. Course fees do not apply to students from the NATO EOD COE Sponsoring Nations (CZE, HUN, POL, ROU and SVK) and NCS.

d) Dress code:

The dress code for classroom-led lectures will be Battle Dress Uniform (BDU). Each student is advised to bring his/her waterproof jacket for the demonstrations.
